1.	Application form duly filled in and signed by the applicant.		
2.	Two recent passport size photographs in color with white background (3,5 by 4,5 cm)		
3.	Passport/travel document must: a) have a validity of at least 3 months after the intended stay b) be issued within the previous 10 years c) have 2 blank pages (It is recommended to attach old passports as well.)		
4.	Letter of accreditation or registration duly signed and stamped by an authorized person.		
5.	Letter of invitation from the appropriate Hungarian institution duly signed and stamped by an authorized person.		
	Letter of reference issued by the delegating cultural institution, olympic association member institution, and national or state sport authority duly signed and stamped by an authorized person. Please note that the letter of reference has to prove beyond doubt your membership of a cultural or sport organization.		
7.	Confirmed accommodation.		
8.	Employer's certificate and salary slip of the last three months. / Pension slip of the last three months. / In the case of self-employment, certificate of registration. / For students certificate from school.		
9.	Detailed bank account statement for the last three months.		
10.	For minors a declaration by the legal representative about the coverage of the costs, certified by notary public. If travelling alone or with one parent (legal representative), minors are requested to present a declaration from the legal representatives / other legal representative.		
11.	Proof of sport history eg.: certificates, medals, contracts, memberships etc.		
12.	Return flight ticket reservation.		
13.	Overseas travel medical insurance valid for all Schengen countries. The insurance has to cover the applicant for at least 30,000 euros or equivalent, for all risks e.g. accident, illness, medical emergency, etc.		

14.	Certified translation of birth certificate (Shenasname)		
15.	Title deed is recommended.		
16.	Copy of the passport and previous visas		

NOTE: Visa service fee is 85 EUR. If the documents you are submitting are in a language other than English, you need to have them translated. The Embassy reserves the right to request further documentation. Original documents must be presented during the personal interview with the visa officer and a copy must be submitted.
